- * All members of the school community will be reminded about safe and appropriate behaviour online and the importance of not posting any content, comments, images or videos online which cause harm, distress or offence to any other members of the school community.
- * The school will manage online safety (e-Safety) incidents in accordance with the school discipline/behaviour policy where appropriate.
- * The school will inform parents/carers of any incidents of concerns as and when required.
- * After any investigations are completed, the school will debrief, identify lessons learnt and implement any changes as required.
- * Parents and children will need to work in partnership with the school to resolve issues.
